Dear Parents and Carers,

We have certainly been enjoying some beautiful Autumn days, and it is great to see the children outside enjoying playing and interacting with each other in the various play spaces. Soccer is certainly a popular activity during breaks, and the children play very enthusiastically. To help monitor the soccer games, only 2 games are played during each break. This has proved very successful in reducing the number of 'issues' that occur during the game. It is also great to see the children playing other games, including basketball, newcombe and downball.

You will have noticed that some sand has been delivered in the long jump pit. 'Yes', it is the wrong colour. 'No', it is not what we ordered!! However, we will leave it in the long jump pit. We are looking for volunteers to spread the sand in the pit. If you have a shovel and some time to spare, please come anytime during the week between 9:00am and 10:30am OR 12:00pm and 1:30pm. Today I am attending a Principals' Briefing for all Catholic Principals in the Archdiocese of Melbourne. A topic on the agenda is the Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools Ltd(MACS) Strategic Plan titled, MACS 2030: Forming Lives to Enrich the World. The Vision underpinning this

plan is "Every student is inspired and enabled to flourish and enrich the world." The 4 strategic themes are:

- 1. Inspired by Faith
- 2. Flourishing Learners
- 3. Enabled Leaders
- 4. Enriched Communities

Our work here at St Bernadette's is guided and supported by this vision, and I hope you are able to see the connections between the vision of MACS and what we are doing here at St Bs.

Also discussed at the briefing was the Allan Labour State Governments announcement of a \$400 School Saving Bonus for all government school students. However, only Health Care Card holders will be eligible for the payment in Catholic schools. Catholic School families are also feeling cost of living pressures and for Catholic school families to be discriminated against in this manner is deeply unfair. There should be equality for all school children in Victoria. Either the payment should apply to all students, or it should be means tested for all students, as has been the case with programs like the Camps, Sports, and Excursions Fund. Watch the space for more information on how you can express your disagreement with this announcement.

I am about to begin interviewing new families for Prep next year. If you have a child ready to start school next year, please make sure you complete an enrolment form and hand it in to the office. We already have 53 enrolment applications, and we will only be accepting 48. We are at capacity!! If you are thinking about enrolling your child in Prep 2025, please do so asap!!

We wish Fr Silvio well as he heads off on holiday this weekend. We hope and pray he has a safe trip and enjoys his time away.


