Dear Parents and Carers.

Last Sunday the Catholic Church celebrated the **Feast of Christ the King**. This feast day recognises Jesus, not as a ruling, dominant king, but a King who serves, a King who cares for his people, a King who rules with love, respect and inclusion. It also heralds the end of another liturgical year, as this weekend we begin our celebration of **Advent**. Advent is one of my favourite times of the year. It is a great time for preparing, not only our homes, but our hearts as well, to welcome Jesus again this Christmas. Whether it be a wreath or a calendar, Advent is filled with many signs and symbols to remind us that Jesus, the promised one, comes to us this Christmas.

Melbourne's weather has certainly had us scrambling for fans, air conditioners and umbrellas - all in one day!! I encourage you to speak to your children about removing clothing layers if they get hot. Tomorrow we welcome our Prep 2025 children and their families to the school for their second transition session. We had a wonderful time with them at the first session and we are looking forward to welcoming them again tomorrow.

Our Year 6 students will be taking part in their transition activities over the next 2 weeks as they prepare for Secondary School. This is an exciting and nervous time for them and their families, so I ask that you keep them in your prayers.

I'm looking forward to seeing you all at our **FAMILY CHRISTMAS AND END OF YEAR MASS** on THURSDAY 5TH DECEMBER at 6:30pm. This promises to be a beautiful celebration of our school year and of the Christmas season we are quickly approaching. Our School choir will be leading the singing.

This Friday 29th November, we are holding the second of our **Parent Conversation and Connection Club** gatherings. 8 parents attended the first session, and there were lots of interesting and supportive conversations and connections. SCHOOL FEES/LEVIES 2024

Thank you to those families who are up-to-date with or who have paid their fees. Could all families make sure their fees/levies are paid in full by Friday 6th December.

SCHOOL FEES AND LEVIES FOR 2025

St Bernadette's aims to keep a Catholic Education affordable and achievable for all families who seek it for their children. At the same time, meeting the requirements and increasing costs, across multiple areas, in running a school.

Our School Fees are also influenced by the Commonwealth Department of Education's calculation of our community's ability to financially contribute to the operating costs of our school, known as the Capacity to Contribute, or CTC, which is reviewed annually.

School funding is complex, so I have included with this newsletter a simple school funding "explainer" which I hope will support your understanding of how government funds Catholic (and other non-government) schools and how school fees support our school.

In consultation with the School Advisory Council and Business Manager, there will be an increase in both the fees and levies. For 2025, School Fees have been set at \$1430 and Levies at \$370. This is an increase of \$150 in total or \$3.75 a week over 40 weeks.

-	Graduation Yr 6	\$20 per student
-	Swimming Prep - Yr 4	\$100 per student

Given the increase in fees and levies, we have decided to keep all other costs throughout the year the same for 2025.

As is always the case, any family who may have difficulty in paying the above school fees/levies, are invited and encouraged to contact the office or myself to discuss the matter.

All families who pay their fees with a payment plan will have received a letter to set up a new payment plan for the 2025 fees and levies.
